

#### **CHELSEA GARDEN 2006**

Our garden design for Savills is an exploration of modernist ideas and vocabulary.

We turned to Farnsworth house, near

Chicago, which was built by Mies van de

Rohe, as a starting point for inspiration.

We both love how the house and landscape work together: the house's

modernist lines somehow lift the landscape and the landscape is enhanced by it.

They are in sharp contrast but balance
each other: Contrast creates harmony. It's
very much a case of the sum of parts
being greater than the whole.

#### Key planting elements

Rodgersia pinnata for structure, Hakonechloa macra, Luzula nivea, Betula utilis var. jacquemontii, Geranium phaeum 'Lily Lovell', Iris sanguinea 'Snow Queen'.

#### Key hard landscaping elements

Concrete left raw, polished or waxed to create a patina. Also white painted render.
